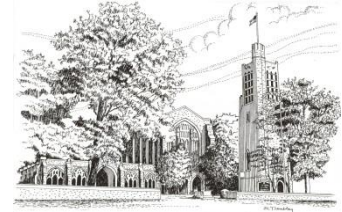
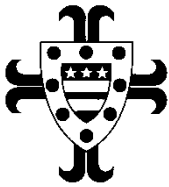

Each Sunday in April, May, June, September, October, and November, 20-minute concerts will be performed live at 1:30, 2:30 and 3:30 p.m. These informal playings, mostly performed by me, are for the enjoyment of our many Chapel and Park visitors who would not ordinarily hear the carillon.
